The Academy invites to master classes, lectures, a series of recitals. You do not need to join the academy as a 100% active participant but ad libitum as an active listener and observer.

The atmosphere and setting

Since 1995 Leufsta Bruk International Organ Academy has been an annual event taking place in late June in the unique 18th century setting of Leufsta Bruk and its surroundings. Leufsta once was the centre of the Swedish iron forging industry. The 18th century atmosphere is well preserved. Leufsta Bruk is located 160 km north east of Stockholm and 70 km north of Uppsala. International airport: Arlanda.

North Uppland - an organ landscape

In Leufsta Bruk church the Johan Niclas Cahman organ from 1726/28 is placed. This famous baroque instrument is the "hub" of the academy for concerts/recitals, teaching and practicing. The participants will also have the opportunity to get acquainted with several historic organs in churches of great cultural interest, i.e. instruments, built by Olof Schwan (Börstil 1783), Pehr Strand (Forsmark 1800), Andersson (Valö 1831), E A Setterquist & Son (Harg 1904), and by Karl Nelson (Östhammar 2000), a new first class instrument. You will also meet and work together with the brilliant ensemble (singers and instrumentalists) Göteborg

Baroque.

Buxtehude & Contemporary organ music

The **theme** of the 2007 Academy is **Buxtehude's music** (cantatas and organ pieces) but there will also be elements of **contemporary organ music**.
